Note: For the MBM Practicum portion, all practicum points require NMSBA prior approval. The candidate must provide evidence, demonstrate achievement and/or develop a report substantiating completion of activity.

As a presenter, the MBM program states "To be considered for points, the candidate must be the **lead presenter** (does not include being a moderator) in a session where the presenter is working for approximately forty-five minutes or more. Beginning July 11, 2002, presentations of less than 45 minutes, but more than 25 minutes will be awarded .5 point. No more than 50% of the presentation points may be accumulated in .5 point increments. **Presentations must be made to other board members or candidates.** Conference programs should be turned in with this *Master Board Member Presentation Form* as proof of session presentation. No points will be awarded when a candidate presents to his/her own board. The Executive Board will decide which points are valid for certification."

This application will be reviewed for approval by the Executive Director and the NMSBA Executive Board at their next meeting following submission. Applications must be complete before being submitted. For example, you must have actually completed the presentations, article or other practicum before submitting the application.
