SB 159 (2014) - Education Technology Infrastructure


SB 64 (2017) – Public School Capital Outlay Time Periods



- Wide Area Network (Cat1 fiber) & Network Equipment (Cat2)
- Support for broadband infrastructure upgrades:
 - Funding (E-rate + PSCOC funding = 80% to 100%)
 - E-rate (Federal) program consultant
 - Technical
 - Procurement
 - Project Management




NM Approved E-rate Funding (% of National)






Maximizing E-rate Budget Use (Network Equipment - Cat2)


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






NM Average Broadband Speed / Student (Kbps)










Internet of Things - number of connected devices worldwide 2015-2025
